


Watsonville Project Homeless **Connect**

Celebrating Our New Pediatric Wing :

Creating Space to Provide Thousands More With Healthy Smiles

October 23, 2014 marked an important day in Dientes history: the grand opening of the Helen Webster Children's Dental Center, a new 7-chair pediatric wing featuring a kid-friendly waiting room and child-sized tooth brushing stations.

Smiles were all around at the ribbon cutting ceremony that included remarks from elected officials, local healthcare leaders and Alec Webster of the Helen and Will Webster Foundation.

As our Growing Healthy Smiles capital campaign has come to a close, we are happy to announce that the \$3M project was fully funded by the generosity of our community. Thank you to all of those who made this project possible, and in particular thank you to the Webster family for their generous leadership gift and the County of Santa Cruz for the support of the Community Development Block Grant.

The Helen Webster Children's Dental Center will provide 8,800 more dental visits a year for our patients, enabling Dientes to provide 30,000 visits for 11,000 children and adults each year.

On October 27th, Maddy, our first patient in the new wing, was greeted by smiling staff in the brightly colored ocean-themed clinic. Since then we have already seen over 2,000 children in need come through our doors and leave with smiles.

Outreach Program Doubles Impact -

Now Operating in San Lorenzo Valley

Dientes has expanded its Outreach Program, a program in which our dental services and oral health education are provided at different locations throughout the county. We are now operating at 20 schools across 6 school districts and nearly 30 venues in total.

A key piece of the Program's expansion is the addition of the San Lorenzo Valley School District. These schools are part of a larger push to improve the oral health of underserved kids who cannot make it to the dentist. Dientes' Outreach program aims to teach healthy habits to young children early on in efforts to make prevention more common than treatment.
