(MPC) one-year dental assisting program. It was there that he learned about opportunities at Dientes, interning there until he graduated from MPC in 2016. This foot in the door enabled him to get his first job at Dientes as a part-time, temporary dental assistant.

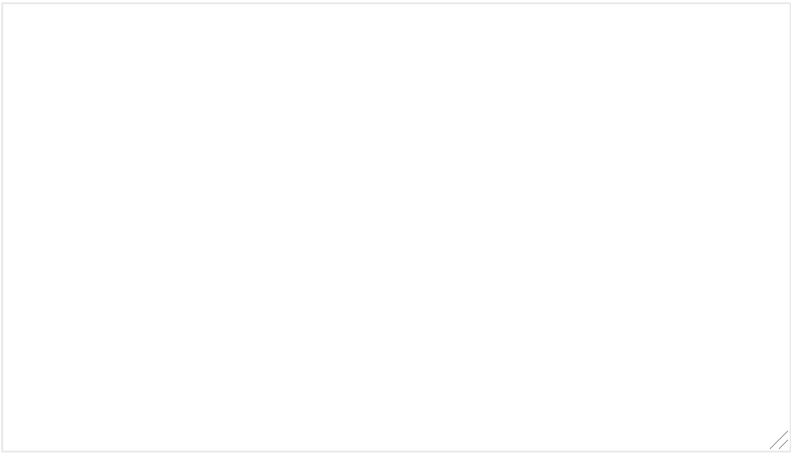

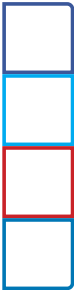
