Hygiene Kits for CZU Fire Victims



Answering the call for supplies, Dientes provided 700 oral hygiene kits to those displaced by the CZU August Lightning Complex Fire. Kits included a toothbrush, toothpaste, and floss.

"This year has been tough financially. It's been challenging to ensure our 11,000 patients continue to have a place to call their dental home," explains Dientes CEO Laura Marcus. "But our community has been there for us through it all. So when the fires hit, we knew we needed to step up do our part to be there for the community."
