




Creating smiles

Since 1992, Dientes Community Dental has helped to bring smiles and dental care to low-income children, adults and seniors in Santa Cruz County

The 5,500-square-foot and 11-chair clinic was the first facility to open its doors at a new health and housing campus at 1500 Capitola Road in Live Oak — a project that has been more than six years in the making. "It's been a very long time coming," according to lead dentist Dr. Ilana Vaynshteyn. "It's great to see patients walking in the door. I know that we have long waitlists for new patients at our other locations, so to be able to contribute to the community and help get more people in is really exciting." Founded in 1992, Dientes operates four full-time clinics located in Beach Flats, on Commercial Way in Live Oak, in Watsonville and now on Capitola Road. They also offer an Outreach Program that provides dental care at 26 community-based locations including schools, juvenile hall, skilled nursing facilities and Janus of Santa Cruz. The mission of Dientes is to "create lasting oral health for the low-income children, adults, and seniors of Santa Cruz County and neighboring communities so that everyone has the dignity that comes from a healthy smile." Dientes Chief Business Development Officer Sheree Storm says the organization served 11,242 patients last year and the newly opened clinic will serve an additional 6,000 patients each year. The integrated, state-of-the-art health and housing complex on Capitola Road also includes Santa Cruz Community Health's recently opened 20,000 square foot, two-story facility that provides medical and behavioral health, and specialty care with a focus on pediatrics. Additionally, MidPen Housing is building 57 affordable units on the campus that will be completed this fall.
