

One year ago, we opened the doors of our state-of-the-art dental clinic at 1500 Capitola Road, marking a significant milestone. The clinic is more than just a building – it symbolizes our commitment to health equity and dedication to ensuring everyone has access to high-quality care.

Cultivating Excellence:Advancing Our Workforce

At Dientes, we recognize that the core of our success lies in the skills and dedication of our team. Our workforce development programs ensure that our staff have opportunities for career advancement. By nurturing our team, we strengthen the foundation of our organization and elevate patient care. Your support has allowed us to jumpstart several impactful initiatives:

RDA-EF and Hygiene Scholarships

We offer scholarships to our team for schooling to become a Hygienist or a Registered Dental Assistant in Extended Functions (RDA-EF: similar to a Physician's Assistant). These scholarships allow our staff to gain qualifications and expertise, paving the way to become providers within our organization.

Dental Assistant Registered Apprenticeship Program

Our new Dental Assistant (DA) apprenticeship program exemplifies commitment to developing local talent. In partnership with the County Office of Education, the apprenticeship program will offer didactic and paid on-the-job training. Our seasoned staff will mentor the apprentices, and the program will create an ongoing pipeline of qualified candidates.

General Dentist Residency Program

In partnership with NYU Langone Health, our residency program is training the next generation of dentists. Now in its second year, this program immerses residents in a practical learning environment where they work alongside experienced professionals to gain comprehensive experience with patient care. We're proud that we hired one of our inaugural residents upon completing their residency and hope to continue growing our team through this program.



Miriam's Story of Compassionate Care

Miriam, a mother of two with a third child on the way, had not visited a dentist in over a decade. Balancing life in Santa Cruz County with her young family, dental care had taken a backseat.

Oral health during pregnancy can impact birth outcomes, and it was during a prenatal visit at Santa Cruz Community Health that Miriam's doctors referred her to Dientes, conveniently located across the plaza.

At Dientes, Miriam received the care she had long deferred. Throughout her visits, the compassion shown by our team played a pivotal role in her experience. Miriam shared, "I haven't gone to the dentist in years, but they made me feel so comfortable and answered all the questions I had."

At the health and housing campus on Capitola Road, the integrated approach to care breaks down barriers, making stories like Miriam's not just possible but increasingly common.





Bridging Gaps in Care:The Senior Oral Health Coalition Program

Dientes, in collaboration with Salud Para La Gente and with support from Delta Dental, is addressing seniors' often-overlooked oral health needs through our Senior Oral Health Coalition. Oral health is cumulative, so it's common for seniors to need lots of care. Yet, fixed incomes, mobility issues, and other challenges seniors face create barriers to getting to the dentist.

Our goal is to increase access to equitable and comprehensive care for seniors through a data-informed coalition and expand partnerships with senior serving organizations to improve oral health. Through this initiative, we aim to create an adaptable, replicable model of effective interventions and bridge gaps in care.


