Pediatric Spotlight:

Making Prevention More Common Than Treatment

Our littlest patients play a vital role in our pursuit to make prevention more common than treatment. Your support helps establish regular care and healthy habits early on in life. This means down the road, these patients will maintain good oral health and need far less expensive treatment.

Dientes has had a pediatric specialist on staff since 2004, but with recent growth, we've expanded our roster to three pediatric dentists. This year, we welcomed Dr. Leri Lipumano-Picazo, Dr. Kimi Abtahi, and Dr. Fatima Khan to the team.

Did you know children should go to the dentist by their first tooth or first birthday?

In an upstream approach, we help incentivize families to come in for oral health milestones, like a child's first tooth or first birthday visit, annual exams, and sealants, by contributing up to \$200 per child towards their Semillitas college savings accounts (facilitated by our partner Ventures).

Thanks to your generosity, we're creating positive dental experiences that lay the foundation for a lifetime of positive oral health outcomes.



The State of Oral Health: CA Dental Director Visits Santa Cruz

This past August, Dr. Jaynath Kumar, the California State Dental Director met with local public health leadership, including the Dientes Executive team, and presented at a 'State of Oral Health' event, which took place outside our Capitola Road clinic.

His visit illuminated the significant strides we have achieved and addressed the enormous need around the state, urging that Dientes and our collaborative work with Oral Health Access (OHA) be a model for others.

Founded by Dientes, OHA builds crosssector partnerships to address oral health. After making massive improvements in access for children, OHA is now planning to focus on pregnant people, diabetes patients, teens, and seniors.

This summer, Dientes opened a new 5-chair clinic in the Harvey West neighborhood after our Beach Flats clinic closed due to flooding. The Pioneer Street clinic is bright and inviting, with upgraded equipment and more space to serve patients like Kevin.

Kevin had not received any dental care since 2011. With the opening of our Pioneer Street clinic, Kevin found an opportunity to reclaim his dental health. After years of deferred care, he needed dentures. Since the clinic's opening, Kevin has had several appointments to restore his smile.

"I've always struggled with dental issues, and it was hard to find a place that made me feel welcome and cared for," Kevin shares. "But Dientes and the Pioneer Street clinic is different. They make me feel like I'm not just another patient but a part of their family. After years of neglecting my dental health, they've given me a reason to smile again."
